<p><b>Unit: Rocks</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Know that rocks and soil differ in their appearance and properties</li> <li>Know that there are different types of rocks and how they are formed</li> <li>Know that fossils are evidence of life and how they are formed</li> </ul> <p><b>Unit: Light</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Know how shadows are formed and why they can vary in size and direction</li> <li>Know that the light from the sun can be damaging</li> <li>Know that light is needed to see things and that dark is the absence of light</li> <li>Know that some materials reflect more light than others</li> </ul>	<p><b>Unit: Stone Age to Iron Age</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Know which animals survived during the Ice Age.</li> <li>Know at least one era from the Stone Age.</li> <li>Know what homes were like in a Stone Age settlement.</li> <li>Know why bronze was used for tools and weapons.</li> <li>Know about Skara Brae and Stonehenge and what Historians can learn from these places.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Unit: Villages, Cities and Towns</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Know what population density is.</li> <li>Know that natural resources are important for settlements e.g. rivers.</li> <li>Know how settlements can differ.</li> <li>Know how to compare land use in different settlements.</li> </ul>

<p><b>Unit: Stop Frame Animation</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Know that an animation is made up of a sequence of images which can be drawn or captured</b> and be able to capture a series of images and move a subject between captures.</li> <li><b>Know the relationship between frames and motion</b></li> <li><b>Know the terms composition, stage and capture area.</b></li> <li><b>Know that a capturing device needs to be in a fixed position.</b></li> <li><b>Know how to fix mistakes in captured images</b> and play a sequence of images back to review and remove images to improve an animation</li> <li><b>Desktop Publishing:</b></li> <li><b>Know landscape and portrait as page orientations.</b></li> <li><b>Know how different font styles and effects are used for particular purposes.</b></li> <li><b>Know that DTP pages can be structured with placeholders.</b></li> <li><b>Know the following features used to publish:</b> -add images -manage layout -shift to add capital letters -return key to create paragraphs</li> </ul>	<p><b>Art Unit: Portraits: Cave Painting Inspired Art. <p><b>Connecting Computers</b></p> <p><b>Know what an input is and that a process acts on the input</b> and demonstrate this using a digital device.</p> <p><b>Know that an output is produced by the process and identify how changing the process can affect the output</b> and demonstrate this using a digital device.</p> <p><b>Know that a digital device is made up of several parts</b> and explain the role of the switch, server and wireless access points.</p> <p><b>Know how devices in a network are connected and that they are made up of a number of components.</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Know that a healthy diet is made up from a variety and balance of different food and drink, as depicted in 'The Eat well plate'</li><li>• Know how to use a range of techniques such as chopping (claw &amp; bridge) peeling, grating and spreading</li><li>• Know that food can be grown, reared, caught and processed.</li><li>• Know where the ingredients come from (e.g. ham from a pig)</li><li>• Know how to apply their knowledge of food preparation and healthy eating to make a sandwich.</li></ul>
